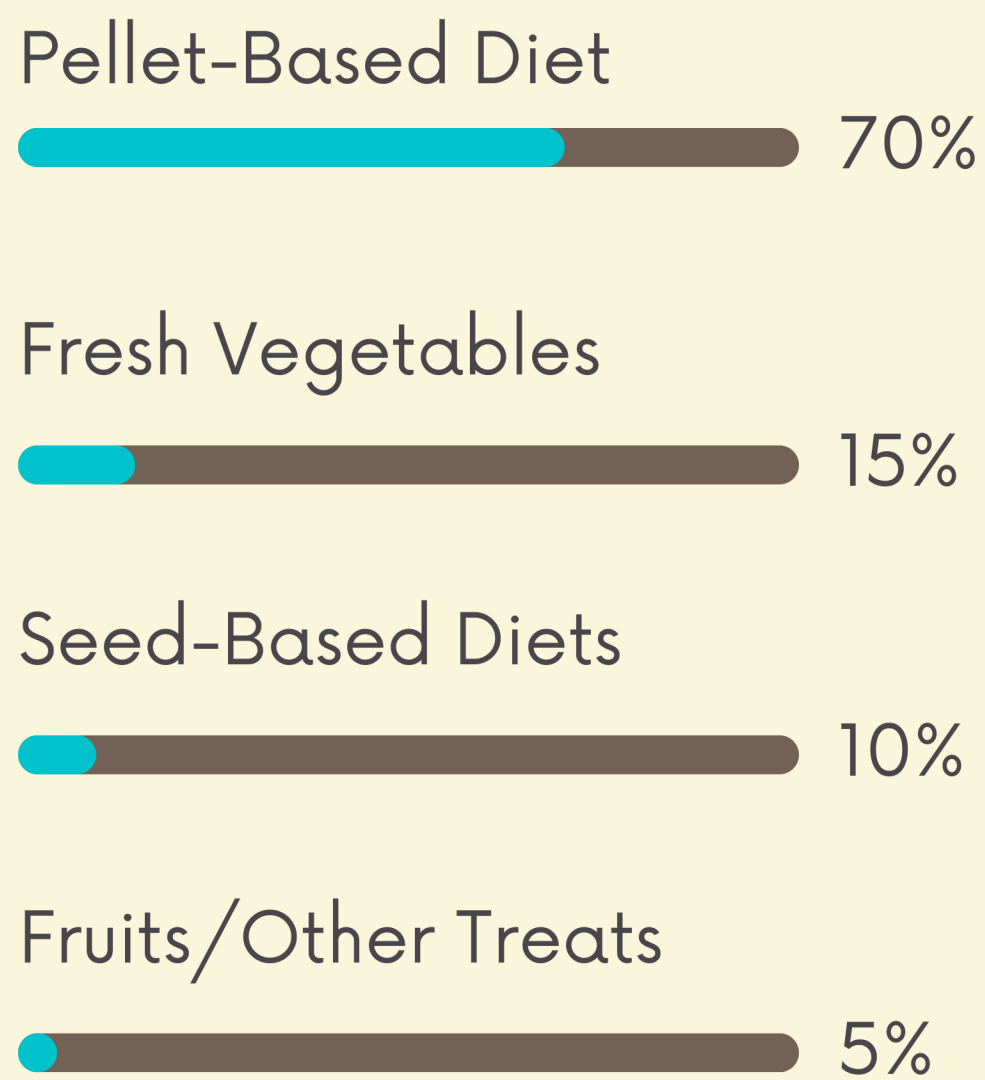

Best known for their singing, canaries are a wonderful choice for a pet bird. Most canary owners appreciate them for the beautiful songs and active nature of these birds, making them very fun to observe. Canaries are best kept in opposite sex pairs, but can be solitary, as long as given plenty of human interaction throughout the day.

### ENCLOSURE BASICS

Minimum cage size for 1 canary: 14" x18" x18"

The cage should be placed near lots of daily activity in the household. However, make sure that it isn't too loud.

Providing different levels, shapes, and textures of bird perches will help keep your bird happy. Although canaries do not chew on toys the same as other birds, they appreciate certain toys like bells, mirrors, and swings.

### MORE INFO

Cuttlebone should be available for providing beak health as well as calcium and minerals such as vitamin D. An avian light for approximately 10 hours a day will help with simulating nature and provide vitamin D3 for calcium absorption, encouraging foraging, increasing appetite, reducing feather plucking, and better vision.

It is best to keep your canary on a pellet-based diet, that is supplemented daily with fresh veggies!
