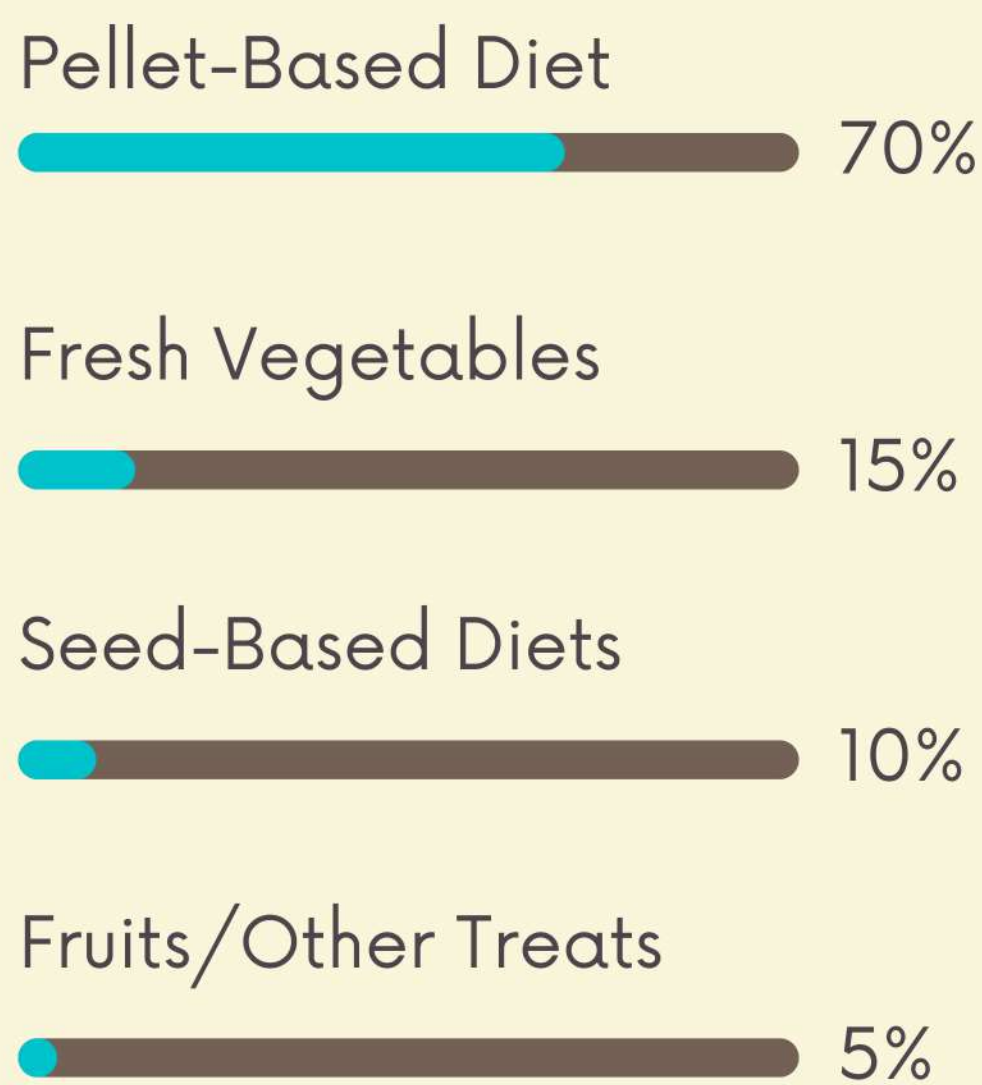

ENCLOSURE BASICS

Minimum cage size for 1 Cockatiel:

- 20" x30" x30"

If your cockatiel is being kept in a pair (which we strongly recommend), then the cage size should be much larger to accommodate for a friend! The cage should be placed near lots of daily activity in the household. However, make sure that it isn't too loud. Supervise your bird during free-fly time within the house to avoid any injuries. Providing different levels, shapes, and textures of bird perches will help keep your bird happy. It is also very important to have a variety of fun toys to chew on and play with, as cockatiels require lots of mental stimulation throughout the day.

MORE INFO

Cuttlebone should be available for providing beak health as well as calcium and minerals such as vitamin D. An avian light for approximately 10 hours a day will help with simulating nature and providing vitamin D3 for calcium absorption, encouraging foraging, increasing appetite, reducing feather plucking, and better vision.

It is best to keep your cockatiel on a pellet-based diet, that is supplemented daily with fresh veggies!
