INTRODUCTION

Finches are very small, active birds that come in a variety of colours and patterns. Finches belong to the family of songbirds, which means that finches are ideal pets for someone who enjoys watching, but not necessarily handling. Finches are best kept in pairs or groups, as to not get lonely. Finches are extremely active birds and fast fliers, which means that the larger the cage is, the better.

ENCLOSURE BASICS

Standard cage size for 2 finches: 14" x18" x18"

The cage should be placed near lots of daily activity in the household. However, make sure that it isn't too loud. Providing different levels, shapes, and textures of bird perches will help keep your bird happy. Although finches do not chew on toys the same as other birds, they appreciate certain toys like bells, mirrors, and swings.

MORE INFO

Cuttlebone should be available for providing beak health as well as calcium and minerals such as vitamin D. An avian light for approximately 10 hours a day will help with simulating nature and providing vitamin D3 for calcium absorption, encouraging foraging, increasing appetite, reducing feather plucking, and better vision.

It is best to keep your budgie on a pellet-based diet, that is supplemented daily with fresh veggies!
