INTRODUCTION

Firebelly Toads are great for a first-time reptile or amphibian owner. They are very food motivated and do well in groups. They are Diurnal, meaning they are active during the day. Firebelly toads are best kept in paludariums or tanks that have a large space for swimming with perches or stones to rest on outside of the water.

ENCLOSURE BASICS

The minimum tank size for a firebelly toad is 10 gallons, but we recommend a 15 gallon or larger for 2 or more frogs.

To set up your Firebelly toad enclosure, use aquarium gravel at the bottom of your tank, and allow it to create a slope to allow for dry land on one side. This can also be done in the form of a paludarium. Allow for stones or rocks to float above the water, so the toads can rest. A filter is essential to keep the water clean, but regular water changes are also highly recommended.

FEEDING

Offer a variety of insects including small crickets, fruit flies, and worms. Any insects given should be doused in a calcium or vitamin supplement and can also be gut loaded, to offer essential nutrients. Firebelly toads are great hunters, so tong-feeding is not necessary. simply remove any insects that haven't been eaten within 2 minutes of feeding.
