Crested Geckos should be handled carefully, as they can drop their tail when stressed, and do not have the ability to grow it back. # MORE INFO

Crested Geckos are omnivores, meaning they love a variety of mainly bugs and fruits. The best way to achieve this is by feeding a crested gecko diet like Pangea or Repashy and supplementing this with crickets or waxworms. Any insects should be doused in a calcium supplement with D3 to allow for calcium absorption. A multivitamin supplement is also recommended at least once per week.

Lighting and heating requirements can easily be maintained with a low wattage heat lamp or a UVB lamp.

### **ENCLOSURE BASICS**

Standard tank size for one Crested Gecko: 20 gallons

> Crested geckos love to climb and explore, so a larger tank is always better. Crested geckos are arboreal, which means that they need plenty of decorations to climb on, as well as a tall tank. We recommend a variety of decorations such as plants, sticks, and cork rounds. The best substrate to use is a mixture of coconut fibers, moss, and bark, in order to maintain proper humidity.
